Fruits of the sea

The Dubai Marina Yacht Club, opening its doors in November, will be as much a home to food lovers as to sailors. Set in the Dubai Marina, the Club employs an environmentally-aware approach to sourcing produce for their restaurants, whilst offering an unprecedented range of premium facilities. Dining options at the Yacht Club, which are open to members of the public, include Aquara, providing luxurious seafood waterfront dining and a casual yet sophisticated deli and food court, 25°55°.

Gearing towards the final stages of opening, Balance went below decks to catch up with Helen Landau, the Food and Beverage Manager for the Dubai Marina Yacht Club to discover the culinary delights awaiting both the seasoned sailor and curious guest. As the first of its kind in the Middle East, Helen explained that it's important to focus on producing the very best across all the food and beverage operations.

"We wanted to create a different concept in dining for Dubai and our focus is on establishing a reputation for fresh and healthy food, cuisine with a twist and a dining experience our guests would feel comfortable with", said Helen. The Dubai Marina Yacht Club will provide a number of dining concepts. Aquara is a seafood restaurant combining Asian and Western influences, served with zest, flair and above all flavour. 25°55°, so named in reference to the latitude and longitude of Dubai, is a deli style food court supplying light meals and picnic hampers as well as a bistro style café.

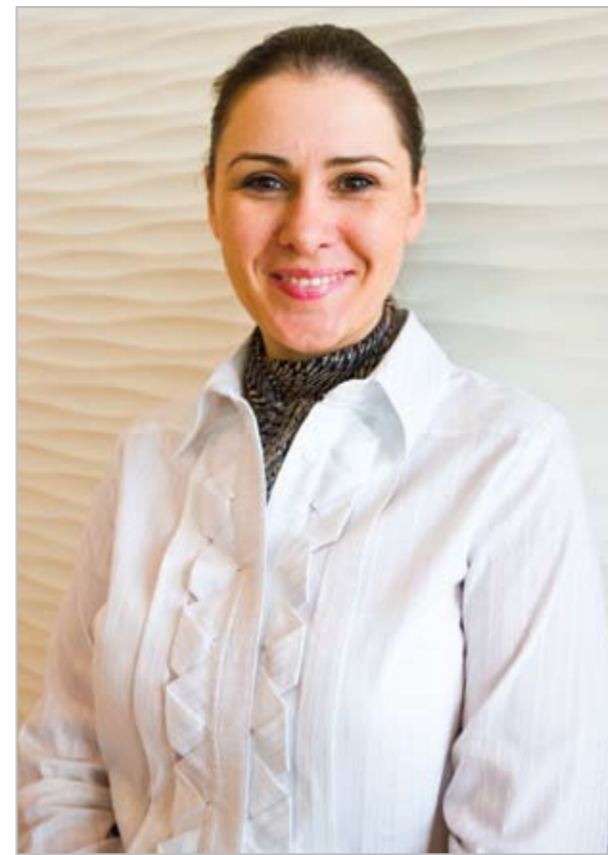
In order to provide fresh produce daily, Helen is looking locally. "For all our ingredients we are looking to support local suppliers and purchase only from those who are environmentally aware in the way they farm or catch their produce. This is particularly true for 25°55° and the 25°55° To Go deli, where we will be stocking a full range of fresh food, paninis, fruit, bread, milk and convenience foods – ideal for lunchtime picnics at sea". 25°55°, is Helen's favourite outlet, "the restaurant is designed to flow naturally along the ground level of the yacht club and naturally creates a fluid atmosphere between those visiting the deli and those dining and wanting to catch a morning coffee. The airy atmosphere has an instant Mediterranean-

type vibe being so close to the water and that is what our dishes will reflect – sumptuous home cooked food with freshly baked bread and personable service".

A popular Dubai dining tradition is the 'Friday Brunch' and the Dubai Marina Yacht Club will be offering its own sumptuous version in Aquara. "Our Friday Brunch package will be especially great when the temperatures drop and we can serve out on the balcony", said Helen, "we have already planned an amazing presentation of seafood for the buffet and have even created a number of signature cocktails to serve throughout the day".

As a club geared primarily to members, the Dubai Marina Yacht Club provides a number of premium facilities including a private members bar overlooking the marina and a bar in Aquara. Apparently the experienced bar staff are also very open to creating any new drinks on request and "we can even name a favourite cocktail after a member if they so wish", said Helen.

With dining facilities available to both members and non-members, Helen is confident the Yacht Club will be a success. "Of course we have competitors within the marina for both our restaurants, but the combination of dishes, deli and dining experience will be unmatched". She adds "I see 25°55° as the ideal meeting place for an early morning coffee, to take stock of the day as the early morning light catches the yachts in the marina and the senses are awoken by the smell of fresh bread and coffee brewing. We open at 7:00am every morning, so anyone wanting a fresh juice before work or a wake-up coffee before setting out for the day will be equally catered for". As everyone knows it's the staff who

make a restaurant as much as the food and the Dubai Marina Yacht Club were very particular about who they recruited. "From the very beginning we knew the type of staff we were looking for. For management we wanted personnel with a mix of local and international experience and for the remaining staff, people with a passion to succeed through a determined personality and above all, a genuine smile. We have a great training team and so we focused on hiring staff who are passionate about their work".

As the winter season approaches, the Food and Beverage team has a number of product launches and parties booked. However, what they're really looking forward to is offering live cooking stations outside. "With the cooler climate arriving, we want to try and create a real vibrant market environment and offer iced tea and homemade sandwiches outside 25°55° on the walk way". Helen and her team are busy making sure all the dining and catering facilities are in order. "We are constantly re-writing the hamper packages we offer for our yacht-owning members and catering packages for Athena Dubai, our charter yacht".

Helen sums up by saying, "We are determined to be the ultimate destination for all those looking for an excellent dining experience, guaranteed".

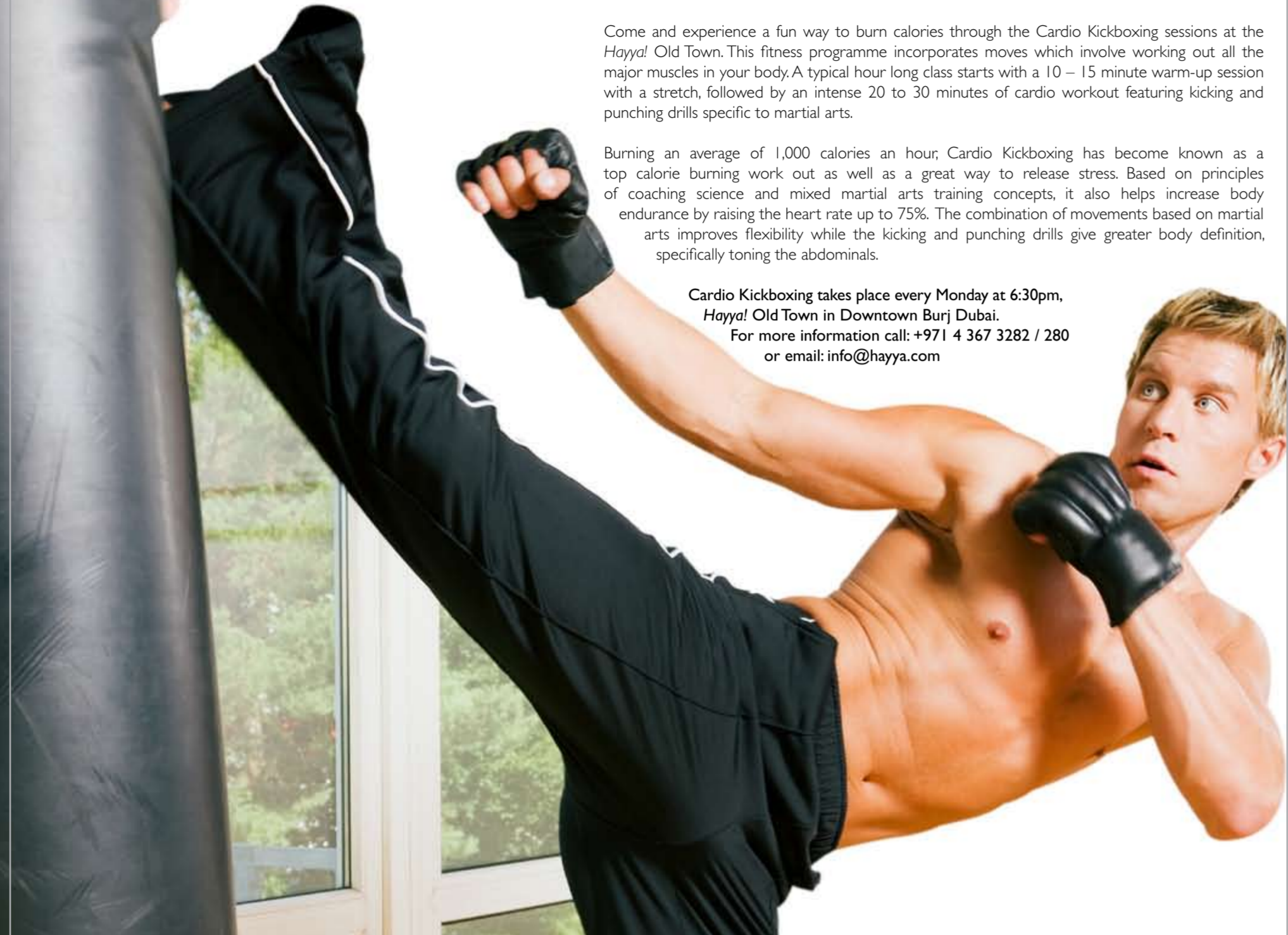

If you have nurtured the dream of playing polo, you could easily start turning your dream into reality. Imagine yourself riding a powerful horse across the green expanse of a polo field and hearing the crowd cheer as you thrust the ball into the goal.

So, get your friends together and head down to the Dubai Polo & Equestrian Club to begin your life-long enjoyment of the sport of kings.

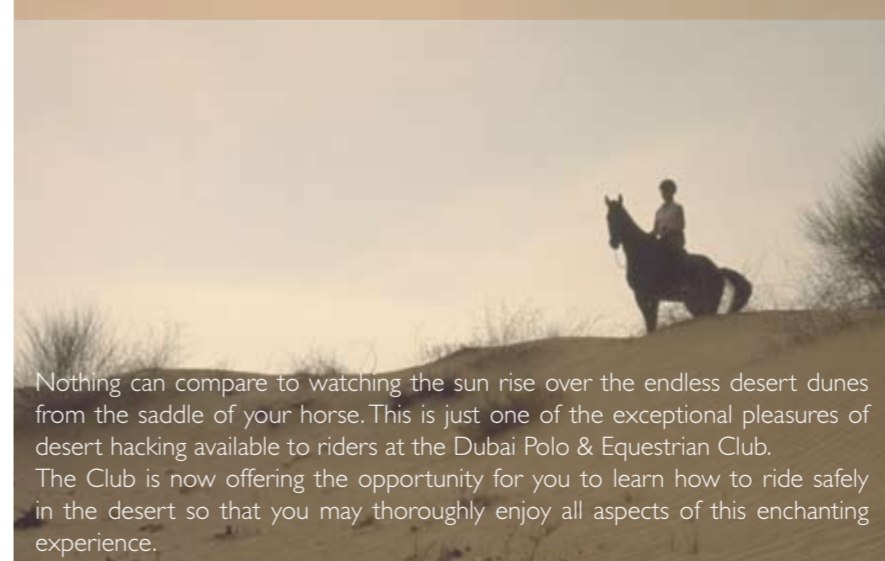

- To make a perfect turkey, start cooking at a lower temperature: most of the cooking can be done in a low oven at around 120°C, increasing to 160-180°C towards the end. You get moister meat if you cook lower for longer. Baste every 20 minutes while cooking and as you do this, the moisture remains in the breasts giving a juicy and succulent main course. To get the skin brown and crispy, heat up some butter until it goes a nutty brown and pour over the turkey and crank up the temperature for 20 minutes before the end.
- For an Arabic twist to your turkey why not baste the turkey with ground zatar spice. Simply mix some olive oil and zatar spice in a bowl and generously rub the turkey with the zatar mix.
- For an unusual stuffing, try chopping and sautéing a few fresh dates, then fold them into your stuffing mix. This will add a slight sweet flavour to your stuffing.
- Bored of the usual vegetables to go with your turkey dinner? Why not take your broccoli and cook it as normal but add shaved parmesan and toasted parmesan. Or try cauliflower and maybe make a nice gratin. To do this take your cauliflower and blanch in salted water. Then take double cream and infuse with one clove of garlic and thyme and bring to the boil. Arrange the cauliflower in a medium sized tray and cover with cream and grated cheddar and pop in the oven for 20-25 minutes at around 180°C.
- Roasting carrots with a little sage and honey can jazz them up.
- For perfect Brussels sprouts, wash them and discard the outer leaves, take the sprouts and at the stalk end make a criss cross with a small knife and blanch for one minute in boiling salted water. Then place in a pot with thyme and garlic and a good knob of butter and sauté with no cover on a slow heat.
- Make your own homemade cranberry sauce. All you need is fresh or frozen cranberries, mixed spice, orange juice and sugar. It also keeps for a couple of months in the fridge.
- For many, there are only two things you can really drink with your Christmas dinner and they are a good bubbly or a nice glass of Sancerre.
- For a great result in flavour and appearance, always use the freshest, best ingredients possible.
- Don't know what to start your great meal off with, why not something naughty like roast foie gras with roasted chestnuts and quince jelly on a bed of rocket leaves or something simple like char grilled gulf prawns with a garlic aioli.
