POST RALLY WRITE-UP: SIR BU NA'AIR ISLAND

On the cruising club's second visit to this natural island, our rally of seven yachts joined the annual race preparations for the Al Gaffal Dhow race. This year, we gained permission to land on the island (normally off limits due to its military status) to observe the festivities of hundreds of members of race crew taking part in games and competitions on the beach. After anchoring overnight, the scheduled morning race for the dhows was postponed due to light winds. The race eventually got underway a couple of hours later, by which time we were busy exploring the beach and reefs of Moon Island.

Shadowing the race fleet later in the afternoon, we witnessed the drama of a large container ship unwisely attempting to manoeuvre directly through the 100 strong armada of dhows. After ignoring instructions to divert course around the fleet, the ship was threatened with legal action on VHF-16 by multiple UAE Coast Guard vessels and the captain of the vessel was allegedly arrested on arrival at port. After having proven once again to be a truly rewarding rally, we expect this expedition to feature as an annual trip to witness the increasingly famous dhow race.
